## **WHY A HOMEOPATHIC PHARMACOLOGY?**

So that in the field of medicine, normality would govern, normality meaning **the general laws of nature and the logical relationships between facts and phenomena. It is the only way to remove some abnormalities that are due to the ignorance of these laws and the irrational phenomena invasion, bringing great harm to the health of humanity.**

1. The first abnormality is ignoring the general law of "**unity in diversity**". The drug concept is unique, defined by the World Health Organization as "any substance or product used or intended to be used to change or study a physiological system or a pathological condition in the interest of the subject to whom it is administered." This concept exists in two specific, different forms, the

allopathic and the homeopathic medicine.

The abnormality is manifested by the fact that the official medical practice uses only the allopathic medicine. Based on preconceived ideas, it is considered that there are inadmissible distinctions between the two types of drugs and the homeopathic medicines are excluded.

Solving this abnormality will require recognition by the entire community of physicians and pharmacists for the existence of obvious similarities between the two types of drugs, with common features much numerous than the differences.

2. The second abnormality is ignoring the general law of "duality". According to this natural law, known as the "Arndt-Schulz law" in the relations between the human

body and the environmental factors, any substance has two phasic, different, antagonist types of actions on living tissue, conditioned by different doses and tissue sensitivity. This law requires the recognition of two types of dose dependent medicines: allopathic and homeopathic.

This abnormality is shown by the fact that homeopathy rivals decided ignoring the Arndt-Schulz law, which has been completely forgotten, eventhough it was considered as the scientific argument for legitimizing homeopathy. In an honest society, knowing this law ought to be an irresistible urge to researchers to develop the latter type of drug, discovered by Hahnemann.

Solving this abnormality requires the study of both drugs in all the faculties of medicine and pharmacy and prescribing both types without bias.

3. The third abnormality - a mistake of logic, represented by the lack of distinction between the method and the instrument of the method. Allopathy and homeopathy are therapeutic methods, ways to use the therapeutic tool - the medicines. The drug is the most important tool for treating disease, the only therapeutic tool used by all branches of the medical practice.

The attitude of the medical world to the two types of drugs is completely different.

The allopathic method is currently practiced by all physicians, without taking into account the method as such, totally ignoring its existence. The allopathic medicine is consciously used

but nobody thinks of it as the instrument of the therapeutic method.

Totally opposed, the homeopathic method is practiced deliberately under this name, but it ignored the fact that, this practice is resorting to the homeopathic medicine.

This distinction made is illogical and arises from the fact that, the science of allopathic medicine (pharmacology) is taught in medicine faculties, without mentioning the allopathic therapeutic method. Instead, learning homeopathy, which is performed exclusively out of the faculties of medicine, is considered as therapeutic method, and not mentioning about homeopathic medicine.

To solve this abnormality, it is necessary for the two therapeutic methods to be considered equal, taught and practiced by all physicians, hospitals and ambulatory, the only considerations for choosing medicine should be of scientific nature.

4. The fourth abnormality occurs also in the field of logic. The need for scientific knowledge of the allopathic medicine has led to the emergence of a dedicated medical sciences, (allopathic) pharmacology. This led to remarkable progress in the field of medicine.

In homeopathy, ignoring the product, as a *sine qua non* condition for practicing the method, has led to the absolutization of the method and made redundant the emergence of a science of the homeopathic drug. The lack of scientific support that could have been provided by homeopathic drugs, caused the stagnation of homeopathy in a state close to that of its occurrence, from over

two hundred years ago and considering homeopathy as an alternative medicine, hence outside of medicine.

Solving this abnormality can only be one, namely the emergence of homeopathic medicine science, that has been achieved through the publishing of my book "Homeopathic Pharmacology" in 2007, the first of its kind in the world, making it possible for homeopathy to collate to the medical sciences.

5. The fifth abnormality is also found in the field of logic and is manifested in literature and professional and scientific societies.

In the world, for allopathy, there is no book carrying the title of this method and also no magazines, for it would not be justified. Also, there is no allopathy society, association, league, etc. Instead, as it is normal, allopathic pharmacology books and journals can be found, as well as national and international societies, associations etc.,.

In full and illogical opposition, for homeopathy, there are hundreds of books and magazines carrying this title, dealing with the therapeutic method. Even so, there is no official recognition of the science of the homeopathic drug, and no other homeopathic pharmacology book, except the book written by myself, published in 2007 and almost unknown 6 years after its development, although it appeared both in French and English. Also, there are dozens of national and international societies, associations, leagues etc. for homeopathy, that ignores the logic behind the necessity of the existence of a science of the homeopathic drug and

also of a homeopathic pharmacology society.

Solving this abnormality, will require the recognition of homeopathic pharmacology as the science of the homeopathic drug, by analogy with allopathic pharmacology, ceasing the publication of books entitled *Homeopathy*, transforming homeopathic societies in societies of homeopathic pharmacology.

6. A sixth abnormality occurs in the drug scientific research. Allopathic drugs, whose mechanisms of action are known at cellular and molecular level, serves as a research tool, a true "chemical lancet" with which to penetrate the privacy of tissues and life processes. Using allopathic medicines, many discoveries in physiology and pathophysiology were made, many advances of modern medicine being owed to using these drugs.

Homeopathic medicines were not used for this purpose, since Hahnemann's similarity law is based on observations of the body as a whole, without interest for the intimate mechanisms of action.

Solving this will be done by recognizing the law of similars at cellular and molecular levels, expressed by the author. Thus, a huge research potential appears - using the Dobrescu law of similars it will be possible to discover treatments for diseases that presently have no treatment or for the ones whose current treatment is unsatisfactory.

In the future, the use of the homeopathic drug along the allopathic one, will bring inestimable benefits to humanity. These

are discussed in the "Drug Therapy" article of the current issue.

In conclusion, for over 200 years, allopathy and homeopathy were used independently. Moreover, they were in a constant war, the longest in the history of humanity. The results of this unfortunate misunderstanding, can be seen in the current situation of therapeutics using drugs. Although allopathy made obvious progress, the benefits for humanity are too small, if we would compare it to the real possibilities of the two methods or other remarkable progress in other fields (electronics, communications, aerospace, etc.). If the two methods and will not change their attitude, one to the other, the drug related situation will definitely remain unchanged for a long period of time. The only way to bring things to a normal path is the appearance of Homeopathic Pharmacology, placing the two therapeutic methods on equal levels in terms of interest, concerns and current activities and harmonious cooperation between them, as two complementary parts of a whole.

There aren't and there can't be any valid arguments to oppose the radical change proposed by the author, because these changes are not some fanciful ideas but indeed they are ideas aimed at bringing the drug scope back on the track required by the laws of nature. If changes are not made now, in the future they will eventually get to lead in the field, after therapy will wander on abberant paths.

In order to contribute more effectively to the knowledge of the ways and possibilities of reintegrating the drug scope in the laws of nature and logic, the author decided to publish an online Journal of Homeopathic Pharmacology. The major aim of the Journal is the knowledge, the promotion and the practice of homeopathic pharmacology by all physicians and pharmacists, allopaths and homeopaths, regardless of specialty, to achieve the final target of health care activities for the population, which is to use equally both allopathic medicines and homeopathic ones, on their own or paired, in ambulatory and in hospitals.
